Deuteronomy 31:6 Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the Lord your God goes with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you."

⁶ So be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid and do not panic before them. For the Lord your God will **personally** go ahead of you. He will neither fail you nor abandon you."

Joshua 1:5 No one will be able to stand against you as long as you live. For **I** will be with you as I was with Moses. I will not fail you or abandon you.

Isaiah 45:2 This is what the Lord says: "I will go before you, Cyrus, and level the mountains. I will smash down gates of bronze and cut through bars of iron.

God demonstrated His Personal commitment to His Sons and Daughters when Jesus went before us **on the cross:**

1. He took your healing personally

Cross-39 stripes (By His stripes we are healed)

- -He carried your sickness
- -He bore your sickness
- -He buried your sickness

2. He took your freedom personally

Luke 4:18-19 "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, for he has anointed me to bring Good News to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim that captives will be released, that the blind will see, that the oppressed will be set free, ¹⁹ and that the time of the Lord's favor has come."

Free in deed

John 8:36 So if the Son sets you **free**, you are truly **free**.

3. He took your victory personally

More than conquers through Christ

Romans 8:37 Yet in all these things we are **more than conquerors** through Him who loved us.

We win no matter what the outcome

All things work together... for the good

Romans 8:28 And we know that **all things work together** for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

4. He took your righteousness personally

He made us righteous

We are the righteousness of God in Christ

2 Corinthians 5:21 For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the **righteousness of God** in Him.
