Introduction:

Background: 1 Chronicles 29:11-12

Main Scripture: Luke 12:13-21 (The Parable of the Rich Fool)

Five Ways to Keep Money in its Proper Place...

1.	Don't let your world shrink to the size of your latest problem (vs. 13)
2.	Have a war-time about greed and envy (vs. 15)
3.	Allow wiser people to you concerning money (vs. 17)
4.	Remember the important money principle (vs. 20)
5.	richness toward God your life's priority (vs. 21)

The Big Idea:

1 Timothy 6:6 says that "godliness with contentment is great gain" (literally "the greatest gain). Contentment is the key to fulfillment and richness. We are all very capable worshipers. The question is, which "god" are we worshiping? When we walk in gratitude, contentment and generosity, we glorify God and feel like the richest people in the neighborhood!

(More in the NT about money than about Heaven and Hell combined, 5X more about money in the bible than prayer, 16 of 38 parables of Christ focused on money, 2000 Bible verses on money and possessions...). Why or why not?
- 4. Read 1 Chronicles 29:11-12 as a group. How would our handling of money look differently if we lived daily as though these verses are true? Discuss...
- 5. Which of the Five Points of the weekend message (based on Luke 12:13-21) was most helpful, applicable or illuminating to you and why?
