- 2. Read 1 John 3:1-3 as a group and discuss the following thoughts and questions...
 - In your opinion, why is living in anticipation of Christ's return directly linked to living a godly lifestyle?
 - If the study of Biblical prophecy and Christ's return is profitable, what are some cautions we might be aware of along the way in that journey? Is it possible to become "so heavenly minded that we're no earthly good" as some claim? Discuss...
 - If we are to spend a few decades here on earth, but eternity in Heaven, why do you think so few Christians seem passionately interested in knowing more about Christ's return, the future kingdom and the afterlife?
- 3. Read 1 John 4:1-3 as a group and discuss the following thoughts and questions...
 - How do you think we as Christians are to "test the spirits to see whether they are from God?"
 - John was writing this letter partly to combat the Gnostic heresy that Christ didn't actually come physically, and even 2000 years ago he says that the "spirit of antichrist" was alive in the world. What primary examples are there in our generation that point to the activity of a spirit of antichrist present in the world?

Promptings:

4. If you are a believer, the Spirit of Jesus Christ lives inside of you! In what specific way(s) does this give you peace and confidence as you interact with a world so absorbed into the spirit of antichrist? How is God making His mark on this generation through your life? Boast in what He's doing in and through you as you share...
