- 6. "The Law teaches if I do this, God will do that, whereas the Gospel teaches since God has done that, I will do this." How would you further expand upon the meaning and application of this idea for daily life?
- 7. "The Law says behave in a new way whereas the Gospel says I am a completely new creation." How would you further expand upon the meaning and application of this idea for daily life?

Are you actively looking for Jesus as the central theme in every text of Scripture? Do you understand the difference between Law and Gospel? Are you fully trusting in the raw power of God's grace to transform you? Close by honestly sharing about the evidence in your life, or lack thereof...
